What's Different About Dolly?

Have a beautifully and elaborately (that's fancy for something with lots of details) dressed doll. Show her to the guests and make sure they take a careful look. Then take the doll where she can't be seen by anyone but you and make one change—add a piece of jewelry, change her hairstyle, remove a hat—and then see if your guests can figure out what's different about dolly!



Foil Fashions

Offer a roll of aluminum foil to each guest—and then let the fun begin. Create sparkling and beautiful crowns, jewels, fashions, footwear, and more for guests and their dolls.



Party Anagrams

Anagrams are just words in which the letters have been mixed up. For this game all you need is letter tiles (you can make them yourself from poster board and markers). Choose some party-related words and mix up the tiles and see if your guests can figure out what they are. Here are some words to get you started: FUN, FANCX, GALA, GUEST, HOST, HAPPY, DOLL, FRIEND, NANCX.



Tiera Time

There's nothing fancier to wear to a gala event than a beautifully decorated tiara. You'll need to have gold poster board, already cut into tiara shapes (that's a job for a grown-up), along with decorations like stickers, feathers, ribbons, yarn, double-sided tape, glitter glue, and markers. Then get enthusiastic decorating those tiaras. Have a grown-up staple together the ends when guests are finished to create the circle shape.
