Build your own boutique with windows filled with all the wonderful things you're planning to sell. It's easy


to make—and loads of fun.

## Here's what you'll need:

- Two pieces of heavy construction paper
- Colored pencils or markers
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape

## Instructions:

- Draw lots of big doors and windows on one of the pieces of paper.
- Have a grown-up cut out three sides of each of the doors and windows. Then fold them open.
- Lay this piece of paper on top of the second piece and draw a thin line around where the windows and doors will be once the two pieces of paper are taped together.
- Then, on the second/bottom piece of paper, draw and color lots of boutique items in the windows and doors so when they open everyone can see what you've got for sale.
- igoplus Tape the two sheets of paper together and add decorations on the outside of your shop.
- On't forget to draw a big sign with the name of your store.
